Kindly inform us through our email ids if you are ready to present your paper in the National Seminar as a paper presenter.

(N.B.:- Selected papers will be published in an edited volume / proceedings with ISBN)

Authors' Guideline:

Unpublished papers written in English or Bengali can be considered. All manuscripts should be typed on one side of A-4 paper with sufficient margins on all sides and the first page of the manuscript should contain article title(font-14, bold, normal, Times New Roman), author's name and present designation or institutional affiliation(Font-12 bold, normal, MS-word format using Times New Roman, for Bengali Amar Bangla Normal). Full paper (within 3000 words) with brief abstract including keywords (not more than 250 words) including notes, references, table, charts etc. of a paper must be accompanied with each MS. Collected papers will be reviewed by the expert committee.

- i) **Margin:** 1 inch on all four sides, paper setting: A4 size, Line spacing: 1.5
- ii) Title: 14 point (Bold) centered or middle justified and fully capitalized,
- iii) **Heading:** 12 point (Bold and left justified), Sub-heading: 11 point (Bold and left justified)
- iv) Abstract: 11 point, Key-words: 11 point.

- v) **Notes and References:** It should be arranged in a separate page at the end of article in the following manner:
- **(a) For book:** (Example: Kisor Kumar Chakrabarti, *Classical Indian Philosophy of mind: The Nyāya Dualist Tradition,* Motilal Banarsidass Publishers Private Ltd., Delhi, 2001, p.191.)
- **(b) For chapter in edited volume: (Example:** A. R. Khatua, "Philosophy of Art-education: Tagore and Vivekananda", *Philosophical perspectives of Rabindranath Tagore and Swami Vivekananda on Education in the present scenario*, edited by Dr. S. Chandra and A.R. Khatua, Redears Service, Kolkata, 2012, p. 172.)
- (c) For edited volume: (Example: (i) Pt. Vishnu Narayan Bhatkhande, *Hindustani Sangeet Paddhati*, edited by Prabhakar Chinchore, Popular Prakashan, Mumbai, Vol. I, 1992, p. 2.; (ii) Pradip Sengupta (ed.) *The Philosophy of Swami Vivekananda*, Chicago Address Centenary Volume and Homage from Visva-Bharati, Progressive Publishers, Calcutta, 1995, p.37.)
- **(d) For journal:** (Example: Rita Gupta, "Apoha, Nominalism and Conceptualism", *Journal of Indian Philosophy*, edited by B. K. Matilal, June, 1985, vol.13, No.4, p. 386.)
- **(e) For online resources: (**Complete website address/ link along with the date of visit should be mentioned, e.g. Downloaded from www.icomdp.org/arguments against death penalty (why the death penalty should be abolished), 03.12.2015, 4.12 pm.)
- **(f) For quotation:** Please maintains this order: (quoted from *My Idea of Education of Swami Vivekananda*, Compiled by Dr. Kiran Walia, Advaita Ashrama, Kolkata, 2012, p. 105.) For second hand quotations, plese use this order: original author and title, quoted in , second author and work(publishers, place, year, page no.)

References should generally be ordered alphabetically, but for specific notes and references used in the text should be shown as superscript 1, 2, 3...... (For example, Music is considered as an important branch of fine art.¹) and related references should be presented in that order.

NB: Title, name of author, designation, institutional affiliation, mailing address, Email ID, contact no. etc. should appear in a separate page followed by Abstract and key-words, but not appear anywhere in the main text of manuscript. A declaration duly filled by the author must be send along with MS. DECLARATION FORM is attached herewith. Please check these matters of your paper very carefully (grammar, spelling, punctuation, consistency, logical connection between two or more paragraphs, conclusion, arrangement of notes and references) before submitting the full paper.
