ABSTRACT

Life style of a person affects his /her health. In the present study a survey was conducted to compare health status between Home and Orphanage adolescents' girl. The survey was carried out at Haturiya, pounchui, PurbaMedinipur, West Bengal. The data was collected for Home adolescents girl (n=15) and for Orphanage adolescents girl (n=15).Different measurements like height, weight, blood pressure, pulses rate, waist circumferences and hip circumferences, body fat(from biceps, triceps, subscapula, Superilliac by measuring skin fold thickness) ,BMI, were carried out. The participants were asked about their total working time and diseases. It was found that there was no significant (p>0.05) differences in body mass index, waist-hip ratio, systolic pressure, diastolic pressure, and mean pressure between Home and Orphanage adolescents girl. But it has noticed that the skinfold thickness (triceps, biceps, subscapula, suprailiac,) were significantly (p<0.05) lower in orphanage as compare to Home adolecents girls. It was observed that more percentage of Home adolecents girls were suffering from menstrual problem as compare to Orphanage adolecents girl






Plate 2: Different activities during survey of Home adolecents girls of Bhagwanpur-II Block area
