ABSTRACT

Life style of a person affects his /her health. In the present study a survey was conducted to compare nutritional and health status between owner and sales man. The survey was carried out at Madhakhali, PurbaMedinipur, West Bengal. The data was collected forowner man (n=15) and for sales man (n=15). Different measurements like height, weight, blood pressure, pulses rate, waist circumferences and hip circumferences, body fat(from biceps, triceps, sub scapula, Suprailiac by measuring skin foldthickness) ,hemoglobin ,BMI, were carried out. The participants were asked about their total working time and diseases. It was found that there was no significant (p>0.05) differences in body mass index, waist-hip ratio, pulse rate, systolic pressure, diastolic pressure and pulses rate betweenowner and sales man. But it has noticed that the skin fold thickness (biceps, Suprailiac,) were significantly (p<0.05) lower in owner as compare to sales man, whereas total working time of Muslim geriatric women were significantly (p<0.05) higher as compare to service holder. It was observed that more percentage of owner were suffering from acidity, headache, fatigue, flatulence as compare to service holder whereas, more percentage of sales man were suffering from obesity, high blood pressure, skin diseases, eve problem, peptic ulcer diseases, hypertension, Constipation, abdominal paincompare to Owner.






Plate: Different activities owner and sales man of cloth shop of Bhagwanpur-II Block area
