### **ABSTRACT**

Life style of a person affects his health. In the present study a survey was conducted to compare nutritional and health status between A Handicap and Normal male. The servey was carried out at Madhakhali, PurbaMedinipur, West Bengal. The data was collected for A Handicap (n=10) and for Normal male (n=10).Different measurements like height, weight, blood pressure, waist circumferences and hip circumferances, body fat(from biceps, triceps, by measuring skinfoldthikness) BMI, were carried out. The participans were asked about their total working time and diseases. It was found that there was no significant (p<0.05) differences in waist-hip ratio, pulse rate, systolic pressure, diastolic pressure, and between A Handicap and Normal male. Significant difference(p>0.05) in body mass index But it has noticed that the skinfold thickness (triceps, biceps, )It was observed more objectives of Handicap male suffering from ear problem,eye problem,leg problem,hand problem,etc as compared that Normal male.
