
### **ABSTRACT**

Life style of a person affects his /her health. In the present study a survey was conducted to **Health Status between Diabetes and normal Women.** The survey was carried out at Bhupatinagar and Raghunath chak, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal. The data was collected for diabetes women(n=10) and for normal house women (n=10).Different measurements like height, weight, waist circumferences and hip circumferances, body fat(from biceps, triceps, by measuring skinfold thikness), BMI, were carried out. It was found that there was no significant (p<0.05) differences in body mass index, waist-hip ratio, blood sugar test and mean pressure between diabetic and normal women. But it has noticed that the skinfold thickness (triceps, biceps,) were not significantly (p<0.05) lower in diabetic women .Different measurements like pulse rate, pulse pressure, systolic pressure and diastolic pressure were significant (p>0.05).


