Report of Waste Management Campaign from class rooms to nearby locality, organized by department of Zoology and NSS units of the college in collaboration with Mugberia Gram Panchayat dated 28.08.2018

A waste management campaign has been organized by the department of Zoology from class rooms to nearby locality very recently on 28th August, 2018. In this camp, students are asked to collect different wastes in three different forms viz. organic waste, dry waste and rejected waste from our college campus and immediate surroundings. College has supplied 3 types 120 litre waste wheelie bins to collect three different wastes. Kitchen waste (from canteen and hostels) and garden waste commonly known as organic wastes are recycled to form nutrient rich quality compost which further reuse in our college and hostel gardens as organic manure for agricultural purpose. All dry wastes (plastic, paper, metal, glass, other dry waste, e-waste, etc.) are separated in different bins and resell to the local vendor. Rejected wastes (including all sanitary wastes, construction debris) are separately collected and managed them at proper place at our college campus. About 31 students participated in the camp.
