Report

Deshanayak Subhas Chandra Bose, a prominent leader in India's struggle for independence against British rule had visited Mugberia locality in West Bengal to address a large rally on 12th April, in the year 1938 when he was the President of the India's National Congress. On this auspicious occasion, the alumni association and Netaji Subhagaman Committee of our college along with the teachers and students have organized a one-day state level seminar in order to commemorate the 85th anniversary of the visit of Netaji to this place on 12.04.2023. Mugberiavillage, located in the district of Purba Medinipur holds historical importance as it was the place where many Bengali revolutionaries and other national leaders have visited for revolutionary practices.

At the beginning the members of the Alumni association and other stakeholders have gathered in the college ground for National Flag hoisting, followed by offering flowers to Rai Saheb Gangadhar Nanda and JyotirmoyNanda (founder of this college). Many teachers, students and ex-students of this college have attended the seminar with curiosity. Dr. Swapan Kumar Misra, the Principal of the college inaugurated the seminar by lighting the holy lamp and gave the inaugural address. Dr. Ananta Chakraborty, Associate Professor of History, Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya has presented the key-note speech. According to him, the event was very interesting in terms of historical understanding of the politics emerged during that time. Dr. Chakraborty mentioned about the revolutionary activities of BirendranathSasmal during the visit of Netaji, the great fighter of theIndia's freedom movement. He showed that,Netaji's visit to this side of the district has to be studied carefully, because there were historical records that



reveals that Netaji's visitto Mugberiavillage were not only to address the meeting but also to meet some rebel leaders of the then Congress Party for some strategic reason, according to him BirenSasmal was one of them. Apart from these speaker, Prof. Ranajit Kumar Nayak, ex-faculty of this college, and an educationist and a philanthropist of this localitywere presented a fine lecture on the mystery of Netaji's death. Sri Mathuranath Tripathy, Secretary, Alumni Association presented an in-depth study of the event by recollecting his childhood memories. Sri Aswini Khatua, GB member were also present in the seminar and gave an inspiring speech on why we should all follow the path of Netaji for a better India. The entire programme was conducted by Dr. Prasenjit Ghosh, IQAC Co-ordinator, and HOD, History.
